A man with blurred vision testified to his vision clearing up as he could read a sign at the front of the church that he could not read before that time. During that same service a young woman suffering from bi-polar disorder and depression, testified to receiving a touch from the Lord and said that "all was quiet now" in her mind, God's peace she had not felt in a long time. The next week, this young woman's Pastor stopped by and told how she had been back to her doctor following that service, and how her doctor had released her from taking the medication she had previously been prescribed. During another service, a man suffering from hip pain that caused numbness and his leg to go limp stood for 45 minutes after receiving prayer with no pain. He tried moving his leg in all directions but could not make it hurt. Our God IS an AWESOME God! No other God can heal like our God!

By the time you receive this letter, we will be on our way to Kampala, Uganda in East Africa. This year our team will be ministering at a Pastor's Seminar for five days, December 4th through December 9th, before moving to another community for 5 nights of open-air crusades, beginning December 10th with the last night of crusades being December 14th. During the crusade, we will also be having teaching seminars for three days before going into the evening services. We leave St. Louis on November 29th and will return on December 17th. Please be praying for these services and for safe travel for the team. We are expecting a great anointing to fall during this time!
