WE HAVE MOVED!! At the end of May, we moved to Hannibal, MO. We have been blessed in so many ways this year. God opened up the door for us to be resident evangelists with our home church, Tabernacle of Praise in Hannibal. This is giving us the opportunity to continue to move forward and to focus more on the vision God has given us for New Beginnings, traveling and ministering to churches here in the States, as well as holding crusades overseas. THANK YOU Pastors John and Julie and Tabernacle of Praise for your investment into missions and NBIM! God also provided Rachel a part-time job that will allow her to spend more time concentrating on the “behind the scenes” ministry of New Beginnings.

PROJECT UPDATE: We give glory to God for the provision He has blessed NBIM with in the process of moving forward in the long-term goals of this ministry. We are currently raising funds to meet those goals of purchasing a truck to be used for a dual purpose: to haul the platform to meetings and to haul farm produce to market. In addition, we will be heading to Kampala, Uganda later this fall for a Pastors’ Conference and crusade meetings. PRAISE THE LORD, we have raised enough funds for the platform and are looking forward to having the construction begin soon. The portable platform will be used in crusades in Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda and other surrounding countries. We are continuing to raise funds for the Conference/Crusade meetings and the truck. We believe the Lord will provide the additional funds needed.



We are excited about a new opportunity the Lord has directed NBIM to begin this year. After much prayer and consideration of a few words spoken over the ministry, God has led us to begin a sponsorship program for children in Uganda. These children are either orphans or children living in poor households where only one parent is alive trying to provide for the family. Some live with their aging grandparents because their parents are too sick to care for them. Most would not be able to go to school if it was not for the Christian schools that have been started by Pastor Moses Ssmanda whom we have been working with the last year. Our goal is to sponsor 80-100 kids to help with food, clothing and school needs so that Pastor Moses will be able to direct more of his ministries funds to build newer brick school buildings to replace the mud and stick buildings that are falling apart and being ate up by termites. For only \$35/month, you can help feed, clothe and send a child to a Christian school. As of now, we are on our way to that 80-100 mark with 15 kids being sponsored. We ministered at Way of Hope in Quincy, IL in June and saw the work of the Lord in many marvelous ways. Two people were healed of arthritis pain in their hands. One of these individuals, the Pastor, had been suffering with that pain for six years. The church had just started a class on learning sign language in which he was taking part of but it was difficult for him to bend his fingers into the proper position to form some of the letters. After the Sunday evening service, he testified to the pain being gone and was showing how he could easily move, bend and form his fingers into the proper positions for the sign language. God also touched and healed a woman who had been suffering from pain caused by an abdominal surgery she had received two years ago. After receiving a touch from the Lord, she testified that all the pain was gone. The healing power of God also touched a man suffering from pain in his knee and a floating kneecap. After prayer Sunday morning, he noticed the pain was gone. Later he began to feel his knee and realized that he no longer had a floating kneecap. He tried and tried, but could not get it to move. God is Good! It was also great to see a young teenager being touched as the Holy Spirit poured out over him and ministered to his Spirit.

From Madison, Wisconsin to Tuscola, Illinois to the small community of New Canton, Illinois, God has been pouring out His love, presence and healing power over many, many people. Below are just a few of the testimonies we have received from individuals who have been touched by God. A newly saved woman in her eighties from Wisconsin was suffering from macular degeneration in her eyes causing very blurred vision. We prayed for her once and she began to notice some improvement. We continued to pray, and by the time we finished praying, she said she could see much more clearly and when she walked out of the service that day she did so without wearing her glasses! In Tuscola, another awesome testimony came from a man who had back surgery over a year ago and had been in severe pain since that time, especially when sitting for long periods. In fact, he was about to get up and leave the service to find a place where he could lie down because the pain he was feeling was so severe, which we were not aware of. That was at about the same time that we had the congregation stand for a time of healing prayer that Jamie spoke over the people. Later this man testified to the above situation and said that after the time of prayer, his pain subsided. He was able to sit through the entire service without all the severe pain. Hallelujah!! A woman testifying to being able to bend her knee comfortably after several months of pain following a knee surgery, and seeing two salvations topped of the morning. New Canton saw many lives being touched spiritually, emotionally and physically. Seven people either received salvation for the first time or rededicated their lives to the Lord. Pain and stiffness in the neck was relieved, ankle pain gone, and back pain cause by swelling and a herniated disk, all gone by the healing power of Jesus!
